

Magic Spell

for cats who don't want to eat



1. Set up the environment

- Clean the litter tray
- Create a vantage point and hiding spot in the pod
 - Use cardboard boxes
 - Provide cage covers with peep-holes
 - Make a donut bed - spray with feliway 10 minutes before placing with cat
- Create a chill-out space or enriched area for play, exploration, and relaxing

2. Give vet treatments

- Clean away any discharge from face/nose
- Give medications
- Follow medications with 20 minute steam treatment if cat has nasal congestion, nasal discharge, or sneezing

3. Follow with interaction time

- Offer (don't force):
 - Time in the chill-out zone or enriched area
 - "Gentling" (soft patting and stroking)
 - Toy play

4. Finish with feeding time

- Choose a strong-smelling, high-value food and warm the food gently
- Set up a raised platform (nose height) with flat plates that do not crush the whiskers
- Offer ONE wet and ONE dry kibble food per meal only
